On Saturday, November 1st, our cemetery was visited by some men from the Bradbury Camp #149 of the "Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War" for the purpose of resetting Sidney B. Suydam's headstone. Sidney died in 1904 and was buried in our cemetery along with his wife and four of their children. Over the years his headstone had sunk into the ground. The brown area that you can see on the headstone in the photo was below ground level.

Sidney was one of about forty veterans of the Civil War who are buried in our cemetery. The men from the Bradbury Camp have expressed an interest in returning in the spring to give a little TLC to some of the other headstones.

Also in attendance on Saturday were one of Sidney's Great Grandsons and his wife, one of Sidney's Great Great Grandsons, his wife and their Daughter.
